All Dairy Cattle may be stalled from 4:30pm, Wednesday 28 March 2018 and **must** be stalled by 8:00am, Thursday 29 March 2018. Exhibitors planning to arrive earlier than the stated times are to advise the Secretary's office for approval. Dairy Cattle must **not** be removed from the Show grounds before 3:00pm, Friday 30 March 2018.

Please note TB Regulations under General Cattle Conditions.

It is taken that on entering cattle at this show you have read and are aware of these rules/agreements and will abide by them.

**DC1.** No cow will be allowed in the judging ring which, in the opinion of the Chief Steward, is unduly overstocked with milk.

#### **DC2.** Production Standards:

The standard of production required is the following minimum standard:

Age at start test	Standard 305 day test
2 year olds	265kg milk solids
3 years olds	295kg milk solids
4 year olds	330kg milk solids
Mature	360kg milk solids

NOTE: It is not necessary for a cow to qualify in the season previous to the Show (unless specifically stated).

**DC3.** The following practices are banned from the Dairy Cattle Section;

- The administration of any drug to enhance the appearance of the animal.
- The infusion of any substance to the mammary system to alter the outward appearance of the udder or milk veins.
- The gluing, sealing or taping of teats or the use of artificial practices to affect the teat angle or teat placement.
- The use of artificial practices to affect the udder shape, teat angle or teat placement.
- These practices, in any form, will be considered an act of malpractice with disqualification likely to result.
- Auckland A&P Association reserve the right to conduct random milk, urine or blood tests.

**DC4.** Limiting of Entries - The Committee reserves the right to limit entries in any class or section in the event of excessive numbers of animals to accommodate.

#### **Age of Cattle**

The age of all cattle, including calves at foot, is determined from 1 June each year. All exhibits must be shown up to their respective age.

- 6 years or over – born prior to June 2011
- 5 years – born on or since 1 June 2012
- 4 years – born on or since 1 June 2013
- 3 years – born on or since 1 June 2014
- 2 years – born on or since 1 June 2015
- Yearling – born on or since 1 June 2016
- Calf – born on or since 1 June 2017

#### **Open Classes**

Champion of Champion Classes – If an entry is made in the Breed Open Classes and such entry wins a Championship or Reserve and qualifies for a Championship Class, a late entry will be accepted provided that the correct late entry form and late entry fee are given to the Secretary or Chief Steward by 8:30am on the morning of the Show or as soon as the qualifying class is completed.

Special Classes – All exhibits entered in special Classes must also be entered in open Classes.

Restricted Classes – Interbreed Section – Entry into Restricted Championship Interbreed Classes 364 & 372 shall be conditional upon winning Championship or Reserve Championship at an A&P Show during the current season. Proof of eligibility to be available on request.

## Points Prizes

**DC5.** All Class and Award Sponsorships are subject to confirmation. Prize Money as stated, scaled or otherwise, is not payable in addition to sponsorship. **All prize money will be paid by direct credit unless requested otherwise. Payments will be made within 28 working days of the end of the Show. Any prize money cheques not presented by the end of September 2018 will be forfeited.**

**DC6.** In the event of a tie for any placing the count back system will apply. In the event of there still being a tie an independent Judge shall be called upon to determine between those tied entries for that place. The production and averaged type points as allocated by the Judges will be aggregated for the final points placing's.
